



CMHS Boosters Meeting Minutes 10 August 2026

1. Open Meeting Welcome back & Introductions - meeting called to order by Jocelyn at 12:05pm followed by attendees introducing themselves
2. Student Reports STUCO President, Roan Blaser - said StuCo had not started much yet but one thing they are working on is a mascot costume (email Ms Cole if you have any ideas)
3. April Minutes approval - Motion to approve from Kelsy, Kolsie 2d, passed unanimously
4. Approval 26-27 Board Slate - Nicole made motion to approve, Lyndsay 2d, passed unanimously. The approved slate is attached.
 - a. Treasurer transition and bank account signatories and access: The Board approved removing previous board members, Jenny Erdossy, Carey Stark and Jennifer Stone and adding Jocelyn Kristiansen (Boosters President) and Richard Moothart (Incoming Treasurer).
5. President Report - Jocelyn Kristiansen - thanked everyone for coming. Lots of updates to bi-laws, policies, budget (senior night \$40 per senior, Banquet \$25 per athlete). Handbook for Booster Reps and Team Parents - we can meet one on one with the new reps before next meeting; Looking for someone to help with the state bag tags, fundraising pays for this - looking for ways to do more for team and athletes during the season to help build camaraderie, community and improve. Trying to reenergize fundraising which has severely declined in the last few years (22-24 made \$1800, 24-25 \$400, 25-26 \$150). If we can get some interest, maybe looking at the Wizards fundraiser again, we have filled the fundraising position (Colleen McCulture) and are looking at new ideas. Karin Wayne added comments on trying to get more student fans at game by making posters (Tennis does this), specifically recommended some reusable signs for girls basketball - maybe that could be expanded to all sports (velcro to change sports); Questions about is there a size-limit on signs; Kris confirmed the restriction is only along Cresta, parking lots and road/circle are fine
6. Treasurer Report - Richard Moothart
 - a. Yard sign sales - sold 23 so far... Swag sale \$1100 at physical night, \$14836.92 in the bank account. Treasurer report attached.
7. Committee reports
 - a. Yard Signs - Heather Mitchler -
 - i. Two new signs approved this year that will alternate year to year! Booster reps help your parents - especially for payment; Heather will let booster reps know to pick up yard signs for distribution;

 - b. Social Media - Jocelyn Kristiansen & Kelsey Hunt - Boosters instagram is very popular, teams encouraged to tag Boosters, Kelsey can help with posts but is going to add some structure/timed posts to keep it manageable.

Spirit Wear - Michelle Wingert - Sports Physicals Night - sales were \$11K, using the swag wagon at all events, Next sales opportunities are Back to school night, first home football game, Homecoming. If a team would like the swag wagon at a game they can request it but must provide a few parents to help. Boosters will need ALOT of help at Back to School Night - stay tuned for a sign-up genius, last year we had StuCo volunteers - asked Roan for that again - he will check, we need to follow-up. about on-line store - not doing but hoping to add pictures to the website as long as contact info.

- d. Alumni Chair - Karen Boley - starting a new committee to focus on community engagement - recruiting Alumni ideas
 - e. Website - Karen Boley - transition to new website in progress; using a new platform called Wix and need to cancel iPage. Perhaps we can get some money back from iPage since we have two years left on our subscription - the Treasurer can pursue it as part of the cancellation process. Nicole made a motion to cancel iPage and move to the new website, Kelsey 2d the motion, approved unanimously. Goal is to go live back to school night. Karen Boley asked for teams to send her photos followed by a discussion on if kids photos can be posted without permission. The rule is a parent needs to opt their child out of photos. Will research if the AD has this info and if it can be provided to boosters reps.
